## Batawa Ski Hill Operations Update

While Covid-19 concerns still exist, the Batawa Ski Hill remain positive that most of our prior restrictions will be lifted. We remain diligent about chalet cleanliness and safety protocols for our staff. All guests must self screen as per the posted signs prior to entering the chalet. We must always adhere to Public Health guidelines so the policy is always subject to change without notice.

For a quick overview of the plan for the upcoming season, here are a few details;

- There are no restrictions on season pass holders. They may visit the ski hill on any day/time that they wish as per the type of pass that they possess.
- Lift tickets will continue to be purchased for 4hr time blocks with maximum capacity limits for each time block.
- Lift tickets and rentals will be available for on-line purchase as
  we get closer to opening day. Purchase of lift tickets and rentals
  through e-commerce is strongly recommended and are offered
  at a reduced rate.
- All of our products and services will continue to be available through e-commerce in and effort to reduce line ups and congestion.
- We will continue to open from 1:00pm to 9:00pm on weekdays.
- The chalet will be fully open and indoor dining will be available.
- The fire pits and outdoor dining through the take-out window will remain and is encouraged.
- Bags and belongings will be permitted inside the chalet but, due
  to space concerns, we do recommend that guests continue to
  keep belongings in their vehicles whenever possible.
