We are getting so excited for Saturday the 22nd of September 2018. Sacred Heart Church, Batawa, old Friends and Parishioners and the Parish of St. Francis are celebrating the 75th Anniversary of Sacred Heart.

It was built in the Spring of 1943 and Consecrated in the Summer of 1943. We were a Mission church for two years before the church was built. The people in Batawa and surrounding area attended Mass in the Office in the Bata Shoe Factory.

Father Dostal officiated. He gradually gave his Bata house to the new nuns and slept in the furnace room in the basement of the new church. Next project was to build a new school. Sacred Heart School came in the 1950's.

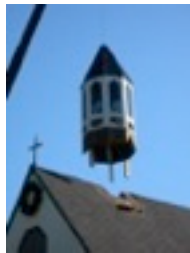
